About KFTSC

KETSC provides employment and training services to Kanesatake'ro:non as well as help and support them in their integration into the labour market. It is one of the services supported by the Mohawk Council of Kanesatake. KETSC is seeking proposals for a Coordinator and Training Liaison to oversee implementation of the recruitment and training aspects of a new project.

About the Project

KETSC received a grant from ESDC for the "Learning to Preserve the Future" Project. The main objective of the project is to prepare and train Kanesatakero:non for specific jobs in three sectors: Indigenous language, Communication and Multimedia and Health Sector.

In the absence of a full-time project coordinator, KETSC would like to subcontract the coordination of certain aspects of the project. Specifically, student recruitment and liaising with institutions as well as course organization.

Scope of Work

Project Summary

KETSC will deliver services to 52 participants by giving them the opportunity to benefit from defined client interventions enabling them to develop their skills and increase their employability and to prepare them to obtain and maintain sustainable employment.



The main project objectives is to provide on the job paid training to 52 Indigenous persons to prepare and train them for specific jobs in three sectors within the Indigenous Public Sector, specifically in the fields of Indigenous language, Communication and Multimedia and Health Sector.

Partnerships for Training

In partnership with the Kanesatake Health Center, the objective is to train and develop new skills for community home care workers, who can provide both institutional and home care for our Elders. In partnership with the community radio station, the objective is to train community members in communications, ready to work at the community radio station or in any media project at large, including in surrounding communities. Project Deliverables

The applicant is responsible for delivering the following: Two signed partnership agreements for training: one for the Communications and Multimedia Sector and one for the Health Sector. Two student recruitment campaigns: one for each of the aforementioned sectors. Two training programs to be delivered to two cohorts of 10 students each, in each of the sectors identified, to begin in the fall of 2023. A written procedures to facilitate repeating the process for other cohorts in subsequent years. Support to the KETSC team throughout the first year of training.

Each proposal received and retained for analysis will be evaluated based on the evaluation criteria below. Applications received from Indigenous consultants or organizations will receive an additional 5% during the evaluation process.
