#### **Field of Activities:**

Under the authority of the Mohawk Council of Kanesatake and the direct supervision of the Perimeter Security Coordinator, the Community Security Patroller will be responsible for maintaining a safe and secure environment for Kanesatake community members, premises, and assets with a presence in the community.

The Community Security Patroller will also liaise with schools and community groups and attend scenes of minor property offences or complaints and will work alongside members of external Police forces to ensure that Kanesatake offers a safe and secure community to residents and visitors alike.
