Study of indigenous peoples - anthropological perspectives (381-10P-AT) 45 H

Knowledge, traditions and values of indigenous peoples (381-20P-AT) 45 H

These courses are designed to introduce the student to the social science of anthropology, with a focus on social and cultural anthropology. The course offers a brief overview of its 4 sub-disciplines: biological and physical anthropology, archaeology, social and cultural anthropology, and linguistic anthropology. The study of these fields will allow the student to learn about the origins and development of humans in the context of their physical and cultural environments. In particular, the student will learn about the First Nations cultures from various anthropological perspectives. The course will provide the student with the necessary knowledge to pursue more specific or advanced courses in anthropology at either the CEGEP or university level.

Requirements

Undergraduate degree in anthropology or a related field;

Oral and written proficiency in English and French is an asset;

Good understanding of First Nations schools and the specific characteristics of education in First Nations communities in Quebec;

Graduate degree is considered as an asset.

Special conditions

Employment takes place during regular office hours from Monday to Friday. It is possible to combine several teaching loads. Teaching loads are face-to-face only to encourage the success of our students.

Working conditions

We offer competitive working conditions: group insurance, pension fund, Christmas holidays, flexible cultural holidays, three weeks' annual vacation, sick leave, telework, work schedule options, summer schedule, etc.
