Part-time Contractual Nurse

We are currently seeking a Registered Nurse (RN) to join our team on a part-time, contractual basis. Under the supervision of the Interim Executive Director, the part-time contractual nurse will be able to support clients in a caring and empathetic manner for the delivery of Onen'tó:kon Healing Lodge's mandate of "Strengthening the Healing Journey".

Some of the key responsibilities are but not limited to; assessing the patients health status and monitors progress, determine and implement the therapeutic nursing and treatment plans, provide nursing and medical care and treatment with a view to maintain & restore health as well as prevent disease, assist the Doctor with clinical duties during their weekly on-site visit.

Background

Since Onen'to:kon Healing Lodge (OHL) opened its doors in 1987, our team has supported over four thousand clients in their recovery from substance use disorder. We are a sixteen-bed residential facility nestled amongst century old pine trees that overlook the beautiful Lake of Two Mountains. Our team is dedicated to supporting Indigenous adults through our six week program using trauma-informed and culturally grounded approaches to healing.

- Must have strong verbal and written communication skills in English
- Experience in addictions is considered an asset
- Experience working in Indigenous communities
